










IDENTIFY LIP COLOR / SELECTING COLOR / ADDING DILUTION + MOD











Add appropriate DILUTION



STEP 1 (IDENTIFY LIP COLOR): STEP 2 (COLOR MIX):

Find the Clients Natural Lip Hue on the FNHANCE Chart Identify the Color Class of the Lips. (Soft or Bold)



NOTE:

The clients Lin Hue is found on the ENHANCE Chart and used as a means for selecting the desired color. In this Example, the client was an A5-GIN. This a CLASS ONE Color and a SOFT Tupe.



Count Up +3-4 Tiles (In the same column) for BLUSH (+4-5 Tiles for a more VIBRANT look) - IIn Same Column (Optional Step) If in SOFT column, Select the BOLD column In same Class. This will make the results more BOLD

NOTE:

Each Class Represents the Soft and Bold Selection. If Lip Color Falls Under Soft (Columns A. C or E) - You Can Select the Next Column in The Class: $A \rightarrow B$, $C \rightarrow D$, $E \rightarrow F$). If the Lip Color is identified as Bold You Can Enhance the Mix with modifiers for a Natural Look.

In addition to enhancement colors in this set - we included the modifiers (HAZE) and (GLAM), HAZE can be used to make the blend more earthy. GLAM can be used on its own and also as a modifier to lighten and brighten the color.
